CONTINUING POWER OF ATTORNEY

THIS CONTINUING POWER OF ATTORNEY is given by me, Ashton Deroy, presently of 625 Murray St Trenton Ontario, on the _____ of _____, _____

Nature of Power

1. THIS IS A CONTINUING POWER OF ATTORNEY and the authority of my Attorney shall not terminate if I become disabled or incapacitated or in the event of later uncertainty as to whether I am dead or alive.

Previous Power of Attorney

2. I REVOKE any previous power of attorney granted by me as of 2020-08-28

Attorney

3. I APPOINT Randy Deroy, of 625 Murray St Trenton, ON K8V 5P4, and Tracy Carpenter of 625 Murray St Trenton, ON K8V 5P. As a result of this any previous marriages to my Narcissistic abuser's mother must be null & voided immediately.

Governing Legislation

4. My Attorney will act in accordance with the *Substitute Decisions Act* of the Province of Ontario, as may be amended from time to time.

Effective Date

5. This Power of Attorney will start immediately and will continue notwithstanding my mental incapacity or mental infirmity which may occur after my execution of this Power of Attorney.

Determination of Incapacity

6. THE WRITTEN DECLARATION of one (1) medical doctor licensed to practice in the Province of Ontario that I am no longer capable of making reasonable judgments in respect of matters relating to all or any part of my estate will be conclusive proof of my infirmity or mental incapacity and that the Power of Attorney associated with this event shall become effective. If I am located outside of Ontario, then the written declaration of one (1) medical doctors licensed to practice in that jurisdiction will be conclusive proof of my infirmity or mental incapacity. In

either case my Attorney will have the authority to choose the physicians.

Powers of Attorney

7. My Attorney has authority to do anything on my behalf that I may lawfully do by an attorney (the 'general power').

Specific Powers

8. Without restricting its generality in any way, the following powers are specifically included within the foregoing general power:

Stay at Home Requirement

- a. To make whatever expenditures are necessary, including home renovations, to allow me, my spouse and any dependent children to remain in our own home for as long as my Attorney deems advisable, having regard to all of the circumstances, including the size of my estate and the income requirements of me, my spouse and dependent children;

Family Care

- b. To make whatever expenditures are required for the maintenance, education, benefit, medical care and general advancement of me, my spouse and dependent children, and other persons that I have chosen or which I am legally required to support, any of which may include my Attorney. This power includes, but is not limited to, the power to pay for housing, clothing, food, travel and other living costs;

Tax Matters

- c. To act for me to prepare, sign, and file documents with any governmental body or agency, including, but not limited to, authority to:
- i. prepare, sign and file income and other tax returns with federal, provincial, local and other governmental bodies; and
 - ii. obtain information or documents from any government or its agencies, and represent me in all tax matters, including the authority to negotiate, compromise, or

settle any matter with such government or agency.

Gift Transactions

- d. To make gifts to my spouse, children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, and other family members on special occasions, including birthdays and seasonal holidays, including cash gifts, and to such other persons with whom I have an established pattern of giving (or if it is appropriate to make such gifts for estate planning and/or tax purposes), in such amounts as my Attorney may decide in his or her absolute discretion, having regard to all of the circumstances, including the gifts I made while I was capable of managing my own estate, the size of my estate and my income requirements;

Charity Transactions

- e. To continue to make gifts to charitable organizations with whom I have an established pattern of giving (or if it is appropriate to make such gifts for estate planning and/or tax purposes), in such amounts as my Attorney may decide in his or her absolute discretion, having regard to all of the circumstances, including the gifts I made while I was capable of managing my own estate, the size of my estate and my income requirements;

Maintain Property and Make Investments

- f. To retain any assets owned by me at the date this Enduringpower of attorney becomes effective, and the power to reinvest those assets in similar investments. In addition, my Attorney may invest my assets in any new investments, of his or her choosing, regardless of whether or not they are authorized by any applicable legislation;

Manage Corporate Shares

- g. To vote any shares (the 'Shares') owned by me in any corporation (the 'Corporations') as my proxy at any and all general meetings of those Corporations, including annual and extraordinary, which may be held and at every adjournment thereof and at every poll which may take place in consequence thereof;
 - i. The authority to vote the Shares will include, but not be limited to, replacing myself with my Attorney as sole director of the Corporations in order to run the Corporations.

Sell Corporate Shares

- h. To sell the Shares or any assets of the Corporations; and

Employ any Required Professionals

- i. To appoint and employ any agents, servants, companions, or other persons, including nurses, for my care and/or the care of my spouse and dependant children at such compensation and for such length of time as my Attorney considers advisable.

Attorney Compensation

- 9. My Attorney will be compensated as follows:

- a. My Attorney will be reimbursed for all out of pocket expenses associated with the carrying out of my wishes; and

- b. 15% of Income to Randy Deroy. Some must be used to pay Kyle Deroy to become a Medical Marijuana Nurse and self-taught dedicated Suicide Prevention Specialist to Ashton Deroy. You know why.

- c. 10% of income must go in to the Business Reserves of Autistic Ostrich. There also is an available family investment to buy in to our not yet legal Co-op. Keep Receipts and allow me to pay back all investments and know investment balances at all time. This entitles you to 10% of profits.

Co-owning of Assets and Mixing of Funds

- 10. My Attorneys may mix any funds owned by him or her in with my funds and all assets should remain separately owned if at all possible.

Personal Gain from Managing My Affairs

- 11. My Attorney is allowed to personally gain from any transaction he or she may complete on my behalf.
